

## Ines Issel Burzynska - Violin

**She was born in Tarragona (Spain) in 2001.**

She started her musical education with her mother Iwona Burzynska. She has studied with Eva Graubin, Zakhar Bron and Yuri Volgin and as a pianist with Vadim Gladkov. Inés has attended masterclasses by Renaud Capuçon, Mauricio Fuks, Miriam Fried, Krzysztof Wegrzyn, Oleg Kryssa, Evgueny Grach, Bartosz Bryla, Krzysztof Smietana, Wiesław Kwasny, Maurizio Sciarretta and Christoph Poppen.

Since 2012 she studies at the Reina Sofía School of Music in the Telefónica Violin Chair with Professor Zakhar Bron (she was only 10 years old when passing exams, becoming her youngest student) and also since 2012 she studies at the academy of elite "Meisterklasse Zakhar Bron Academy" in Interlaken (Switzerland).

In her short but intense artistic career she has achieved many significant successes. She is a laureate of **the nineteen first prizes** in national and international competitions, among them it is the winner of the first prize at the 13th and 15th International Violin Competition in honor of Karol Lipiński and Henryk Wieniawski in Lublin in 2015 and 2021 respectively.
